Welcome to Class FS and Year 6. This final year at Brierley C of E School is extremely important so if you have any queries or concerns please feel free to see me before or after school.

This half term Class F.S will be studying:

History - Who was John Lennon? Why is he an important figure in modern history? What was life like in the 1960's?

Literacy - Biographies and autobiographies - we will be researching the life of John Lennon and other important figures from the 1960's to write their biographies as well as attempting to write our own short autobiography.

Numeracy - Rounding large whole and decimal numbers, comparing and ordering numbers and the addition written method.

Science - Animals including humans - we will look at how water and nutrients are transported in the digestive systems and how to keep our bodies fit and healthy.

ICT - Computer coding— we will be studying how computer programs work and will begin to develop our own simple games.

P.S.H.E - It's good to be me - we will be thinking about our skills and hobbies and how this can shape our choices as we grow up.

R.E - Islam - what can be learnt from the lives of significant people of faith.

Music— Lyrics and melody - we will be listening to and adapting the lyrics to our favourite Beatles song.

French - Class FS will have a weekly French lesson on Thursday afternoons learning words and phrases linked to our topics.

P. E - weather permitting we will be outside playing basketball we will also receive training from Team Activ to become school sports leaders.

D & T— we will be exploring the design of textiles. Linking to our history topic we will research the fashions of the 1960's and design our own 1960's inspired t-shirt.
