With us using the whole day and offering two types of appointment, we are expecting the hall to be less full which will hopefully allow you to have a fuller picture of how your child has settled in to this new school year, and to ask any questions you might have.

Appointments are being made through our school website app. If you are experiencing any problems with this, please speak to our office staff who will be able to help.

Please note that our staff are available to speak with you before and after school throughout the school year, not just on parent consultation days so if you have anything you are concerned about or would like to ask, please contact our office, we will arrange a call back or meeting.
