Uniform

When it is your child's PE day, they may come to school wearing their PE kit.

These kits must not be football replica or other branded sports kits – they must comply with school PE uniform. By doing this, we will free up the time it takes for children to get changed, giving them more time for taking part in sports.

We hold a number of spare kits in school, so if your child forgets theirs, they will still be expected to take part in PE lessons, wearing the spare kits we can provide.

On all other days your child must come to school in full school uniform, including black school shoes.

Uniform is as follows:

Boys Uniform

Red school sweatshirt

White shirt or white polo shirt

Dark/Mid Grey trousers or shorts

Black shoes or sandals (trainers are NOT allowed to be worn in school)

Boots worn in winter will be accepted, but preferably if they can be changed for plimsolls indoors.

White, grey or black socks

Girls Uniform

Red school sweat shirt or cardigan

White blouse or white polo shirt

Dark/Mid Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers

Red and white gingham dress

Black shoes or sandals (trainers are NOT allowed to be worn in school)

Boots worn in winter will be accepted, but preferably if they can be changed for plimsolls indoors

White, grey or black socks or tights

Jewellery

Children may wear small stud ear rings – (no hoops or dangling ear rings)

Earrings can not be taped over so must be removed for sporting activities

A classic watch may be worn (no smart watches)

No other jewellery is permitted without the approval of the head teacher

P.E. Kit

Black shorts

White T-shirt

Tracksuit and trainers (if outdoors)

Swimming Kit

Dark one-piece swimsuit for girls

Swimming trunks (not shorts) for boys

Towel

Swimming cap if desired

All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons
