Spain	A large country in Western Europe. Madrid is the capital city.
Europe	The second smallest of the world's seven continents. The continent on which Spain and Great Britain are situated.
Hispanic	Hispanic refers to people who speak Spanish or who are descendants of those from Spanish-speaking countries.
La Sagrada Família	A very famous Roman Catholic Church in Barcelona.
Flamenco	A traditional Spanish dance involving acoustic guitar music, singing, rhythmic hand clapping, heel stamping, fans and castanets.
Talavera	Talavera is a city in central Spain. It has been famous since the 15th century for its creative patterns in tiles and ceramics. Hand painted, no two tiles are ever the same.
Día de los muertos	The Day of the dead. This originated from the Aztec belief that rather than being sad, we should celebrate the lives of the deceased with food, drink, parties and fun activities.
